## SEASON RECAP: 2016

In 2016 the West Ranch Wildcats baseball team had a year to remember. Their final record was 24-10 with an 11-4 Foothill League record while winning the program's third Foothill League title.

Also, the Wildcats advanced to the semi-finals of the C.I.F. Division - 1 playoffs matching the deepest playoff run the team has made. Previously, the 2012 Wildcats made it to the semi-final round, as well.

Along the way the Wildcats piled up impressive victories out of league play against Mater Dei, El Toro, Norco, and Oaks Christian. During Foothill League play, the Wildcats won 9 of their last 10 games including the final two versus Valencia to earn a league title with a celebration on the Vikings field.

West Ranch graduated twelve seniors with nine of them moving on to compete in collegiate baseball; two are playing D-1 (University of Oregon & San Jose State), one is playing D-2 (UC San Diego), and six are playing junior college (L.A. Mission and Moorpark).

The 2016 West Ranch team also set numerous program statistical records and was near the top of any team in program history:

Highlights from the 2016 season: Easton Tournament: finished with a 4-1 record  
Santa Ana Elks Tourney Champions:

April 6th: Jack Cunningham got the start against Tustin and threw five solid innings in the semi-final round of the Elks tournament. Blake Baumgartner hit the go-ahead, 2-run homerun in the top of the 7th with Timmy Josten earning the win throwing a scoreless bottom half to advance to the championship game with a 6-5 win.

April 6th: Just a few hours after the semi-final win over Tustin, Jason Drees led the team to a tournament championship scoring twice with two hits and one RBI. Austin Hernandez drove in two runs and Michael Rosati struck out 7 batters earning the win.

April 13th: Jack Cunningham threw a no-hitter beating Golden Valley 11-0. He struck out 10 batters. Alex Lee had three RBI on the day.

April 22nd: Jason Drees hit three homeruns guiding the team to a 5-1 victory at Hart. Timmy Josten earned the win striking out 8 batters in 6 innings.

May 7th: After a rainout the day before, completed the season sweep over Canyon with a 6-1 win. Dom Eberle and Simon Pilato combined to throw a 3-hitter. Danny Luevano had 3 RBI.

May 12th: Captured the program's third Foothill League title traveling to Valencia and beating the Vikings 4-3. Timmy Josten threw a complete game striking out 7 batters. Blake Baumgartner made a game-saving play to end the 5th inning to help preserve the win. Nico Valdez scored the go-ahead run on a passed ball and also contributed a RBI double.

May 20th: Won the first round, C.I.F. Division-1 playoff game versus Mater Dei. Austin Hernandez hit the go-ahead 3-run homerun in the bottom of the 6th for the win. Blake Baumgartner hit a homerun. Alex Lee robbed a homerun in left field.

May 24th: Won the second round, C.I.F. Division-1 playoff game at Norco. Jack Cunningham threw a complete game for the 3-2 victory. Nico Valdez squeezed in Doug Gragg and Danny Luevano to put the Wildcats ahead for good.

May 27th: Won the quarterfinal C.I.F. Division -1 playoff game at El Toro, ranked #4 in the nation by Max Preps, with a 2-1 win. Timmy Josten threw a complete game striking out five batters on four hits. Cade Spurlin had a double and a run scored.

# 2017 SEASON PREVIEW

## A Message from the Head Coach

The 2017 West Ranch varsity baseball team is dedicated to continuing the successful progression of Wildcat baseball. The program is coming off another Foothill League title and a deep run in the CIF Division 1 playoffs. Wildcat seniors and their teammates have grinded out another productive off-season and have put in the effort needed to have a big 2017 spring season. Spring 2017 looks promising both on and off the field. The varsity squad has a great mix of returning veteran players and new talented underclassmen who have already shown great promise and maturity. The current roster boasts several talented baseball players and one of the highest GPAs in school history. We invite you all to sit back and enjoy the 11th season of Wildcat Baseball!

On the mound returning all-state pitcher Timmy Josten returns to be the ace of the staff. The senior will find the ball in his hands all season long in the most important games of the season. Looking to be the 2nd starting arm are several talented pitchers. Senior Dom Eberle had success last season starting several games for the Cats and is looking to increase his contribution this year. Talented junior left hander Alex Burge has had a great off-season. Tall and lanky sophomore JD Callahan will also compete for starting role this season.

The bullpen is full of talented arms. Senior sidewinder Bryan Delgado with senior position players Chris Gaff and Nico Valdez will give the pitching staff some senior experience. Junior right hander Brenden Fisher along with catcher Christos Stefanos will add depth to this year's group of hurlers.

The Wildcats are blessed to have three varsity caliber catchers at the Ranch. Junior Christos Stefanos, sophomore Chris Freeman, and freshmen Nicholas Perez will all battle for playing time. All three players are solid defensively and have the ability to hit in the heart of the batting lineup.

Third base has been anchored all winter by senior Chris Gaff who has shown the ability to defend the hot spot well. Others looking for time at third base are Chris Freeman and Nicholas Perez.

First base is the home of some talented offensive players. Junior switch hitter Will Chambers looks to get the bulk of the time after a productive off-season. Timmy Josten has shown a solid glove at first and has had several big hits over the last couple seasons. Chris Gaff and JD Callahan add depth to first base.

Senior Nico Valdez is the anchor of the Wildcat defense and will be the leader from the short-stop position. He is the catalyst of the team and will be responsible for the success of the Wildcats on the diamond. At second base, senior Austin Hernandez will add athleticism to the middle infield. His bat will be in the top part of the lineup and will be a driving force of the offense. Alex Lee and Nicholas Perez add depth to the infield.

In the outfield there are several talented seniors and a new crop of athletic underclassmen generating a competition for playing time. Returning senior starter Alex Lee will be asked to have another big year. Garren Bui, Dom Eberle, and Robert Pablos are all capable seniors who can both defend and hit. Juniors Alex Burge and Evan Gellatly are talented baseball players who will push the seniors for time in the outfield. Then there is an exciting trio of speedy and athletic sophomores ready to compete for starting jobs. Twins, Jovan Camacho and Ryan Camacho, have proven this fall that they deserve to be in the lineup. Garrett Monheim is the third sophomore who has shown the ability to work his way into the lineup, as well.

The 2017 Wildcats have a great mix of senior leadership and young talent as they look to capture back-to-back Foothill League titles.

Coach Burrill grew up in the SCV and played baseball at the Pony fields (when there were only four fields) and currently resides in Newhall.

Casey Burrill played high school baseball at Hart High School, where he was a two time All-CIF catcher. He was drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates but chose USC instead. Casey was a first team All-American at USC and hit .408 his senior year to lead the Pac-10. He was then drafted by the Atlanta Braves where he played minor league baseball.

Coach Burrill started his coaching career at Valencia High School where he was an assistant for two years. He was then named the Saugus Varsity Coach in 2000 replacing the only baseball coach in Saugus history, Doug Worley. Saugus went to the 2nd round of the CIF playoffs during his last year at the helm. He finished his career at Saugus with a 64-37-3 record. Saugus Baseball players under Coach Burrill have attended universities such as USC, Loyola, Michigan State, Fresno State, Cal Poly, Sonoma State, North Texas, CSUN, Cal Lutheran, UC Irvine, Cal State San Francisco, Concordia, and many others. While at Saugus, he taught business, video production, and computers. He earned the Saugus High School "Teacher of the Year" award in 2001. He also served as the athletic director for two and half years. After four years at the Saugus helm, he was named the West Ranch Head Coach. He leaves behind many great friends, players, parents, coaches, and memories at Saugus.

The chance for the coaching staff (including his brother Brady) to all be at the same high school teaching and coaching together, was just too tough to pass up. West Ranch was the perfect fit. Casey teaches web design and AP computer science at West Ranch. Burrill is married to Kristin who is a Physical Education teacher at Placerita Jr. High. They have two children, Kari (College of the Canyons) and Corey (California Lutheran University). He is also the older brother of assistant coach Brady Burrill and son of Jerry Burrill, teacher in the William S Hart School District for over 30 years. His sister Mitzi teaches math at Rio Norte JrHS. Burrill's brother-in-law (Rob Mandel) and sister-in-law (Jen Burrill) teach at Valencia HS.

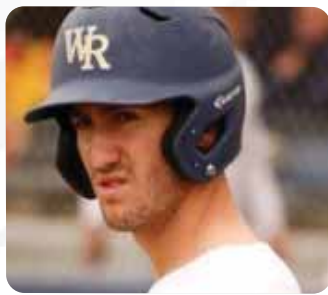

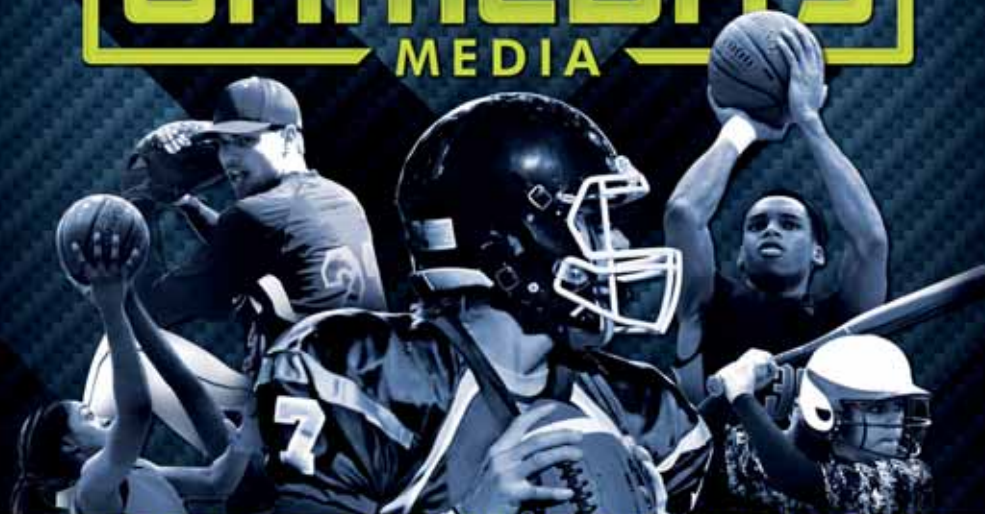
